



International Tuition 2026–2027

At Grace Christian School we pursue excellence, and desire your child to do the same. GCS operations are fully funded through tuition. This allows us to deliver our mission of inspiring each student to live with character, learn with excellence, and love with the hands of Jesus, while also focusing on strategic priorities for the future.

Annual Tuition: The first tuition payment is due in the form of the **\$2,500 Enrollment Deposit** to reserve a seat in the class and receive the Form I-20. Tuition is non-refundable and the remainder must be paid in full by July 1, unless a semester payment plan is requested.

Single Semester Tuition is \$12,250.

Room and Board: Grace Christian School requires all students to live with an English-speaking adult who is at least 25 years of age. Grace Christian School will secure living accommodations for the entire school year either in the school dormitory or with a host family. Payment is due by July 1, 2026. A student remaining with a host family after June 15, 2027 must notify the Admissions Office and will be charged accordingly. An increased summer rate will apply. The GCS dormitory will close after June 15.

Medical Insurance (if needed): Grace Christian School requires all students to have medical insurance. If a student has already purchased medical insurance through a school placement agency or U.S. relative, proof of coverage must be presented to GCS by August 12, after which he or she will be automatically signed up for insurance and billed accordingly. Medical insurance purchased through the school will be effective until the end of the school year. A student remaining with a host family over summer break must notify the Admissions Office and will be charged for extended medical insurance coverage.
